SUPPORTING LOW-INCOME CHILDREN & FAMILIES

Up to 3 children in a family may receive a scholarship. CSFP assists families in finding schools that provide a good fit for their children. Families can transfer their scholarship to another private school at any time.

CHAMPIONING EQUITY

CSFP has no religious or political affiliation, a factor that sets us apart from other scholarship organizations. Our 170 diverse educational partners include independent, special needs, and faith-based schools.

Students are selected from a random, needs-based lottery, and come from low-income households in all corners of the city.

MAKING A HUGE IMPACT


96% of CSFP alumni graduate high school prepared and on time, compared to 67% of Philadelphia public school students.

PA Tax Bill	\$10,000
Donation Amount	\$10,000
Tax Credit (90%)	\$9,000
Net Federal Tax Benefit **	\$2,400
Net Cost for Donor ***	\$0
Impact *	5 lives impacted

HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

You may obtain credits for a portion or all of your tax liability. Businesses can receive up to \$750,000 in tax credits per year.

New 2018 applications accepted only on July 2.

Credits are first-come, first-served, and often fully utilized on opening day, so CSFP will help you apply on July 2.

Renewing companies must apply on May 15.

Companies entering year 2 of a two-year tax credit commitment, or companies renewing a two-year commitment that just ended, must apply on May 15.
