2021 Accomplishments (continued)

CSFP AWARDED MORE NEW SCHOLARSHIPS THAN EVER BEFORE

As part of the 20th anniversary celebration, CSFP committed to award an additional 500 scholarships to families and students to attend schools of choice for the 2022-2023 School Year. The total number of available new scholarships increased 25 percent from 2,000 to 2,500 — meaning that CSFP provided 2,500 new scholarships for Philly Kids. This resulted in 5,400 scholarships for children to attend quality, safe schools of choice.





CSFP ENHANCED THE PROGRAM AMBASSADOR INITIATIVE

In 2021, CSFP expanded the Program Ambassador (PA) program to offer professional development and leadership opportunities to CSFP parents. Historically, the PAs worked directly with families at their CSFP partner schools to share information, resources, and answer questions about CSFP scholarships.

With support from key donors like the Connelly Foundation and William Penn Foundation, CSFP empowered 31 PAs to offer school-specific support to families. CSFP provided seven PA training seminars in school selection, school communication, youth conflict resolution and mediation, and financial literacy. CSFP surveyed PAs who attended each workshop, and all attendees found the workshops to be valuable and would recommend them to CSFP families.

Outcomes and Achievements

5,472 students received a CSFP scholarship in the 2021-2022 School Year.



This year CSFP families chose 149 CSFP partner schools for their students to attend.



CSFP provided more than \$10 million in scholarships.

76% of CSFP scholars utilize

scholarships to attend tuition-based schools as an alternate to low-performing public schools.*

77% of CSFP scholars live in low-performing school neighborhoods.

The average household income of a CSFP family of four is

CSFP **7th** graders perform at or above the national average in both reading and math.



93% of CSFP alumni attend schools of choice.


98%

of CSFP alumni in the class of 2020 **graduated on-time** (as compared to 69% in the Philadelphia School District).



93% of CSFP alumni in the class of 2020 reported plans to attend college after high school.

70% of CSFP alumni in the high school class of 2019 enrolled in college (in comparison, only 54% of Philadelphia School District students attended college that year, and only 28% nationally in the same household income range).
